AVAILABLE ROLES

APPLICATION PROCESS

Follow the instructions below to apply:

1. Register with the [PMCV allocation and Placement service](#).
2. Review the [position description](#) and complete the general application form. You'll also need to upload:
 - a cover letter addressed to Orygen Mental Health Graduate Nurse Coordinator
 - an up-to-date resume (three pages maximum) including a professional photo
 - your most recent academic transcript
 - details of two referees who can be your clinical placement referees or a manager if you're employed.
3. You'll need to submit two of your most recent clinical appraisals. At least one must be from a mental health clinical placement. You can add these to your PMCV registration.

Applications open at 10am on Monday 5 June and close at 7pm on Friday 7 July 2023. When the applications open you can apply directly from the [Melbourne Health site](#).

INTERVIEW PROCESS

Orygen will hold individual face-to-face interviews from Monday 17 to Thursday 20 July 2023. If you're selected for interview, we'll contact you with a date and time for your interview.

You'll need to bring a certified copy of your academic transcript, professional passport photo and two written references with you to your interview.

OUTCOME AND OFFER

The PMCV outcome will be published at 10am on Monday 2 October 2023. You'll receive a notification from PMCV with your outcome. If you're offered a position, you'll have 72 hours to accept the offer. We'll be in touch with you after this time.
